Acceptable Items:

Mercury thermometers, Drain & Oven Cleaners, Upholstery Cleaners, Poisons, Insecticides, Oil- or Lead-Based Paints, Wood Cleaners, Aerosols, Strippers & Varnishes, Metal Polishers, Pool & Photo Chemicals, Automotive Cleaners & Fluids, Grease & Rust Solvents, and Fluorescent Bulbs.

Non-Acceptable Items:

NO LATEX PAINT, **No** Smoke Detectors, **No** Auto Batteries, **No** Motor Oil, **No** Radioactive or Medical Waste, **No** Asbestos, **No** Explosives, and **No** Compressed Gas Cylinders.

****LATEX PAINT IS NOT ACCEPTED****

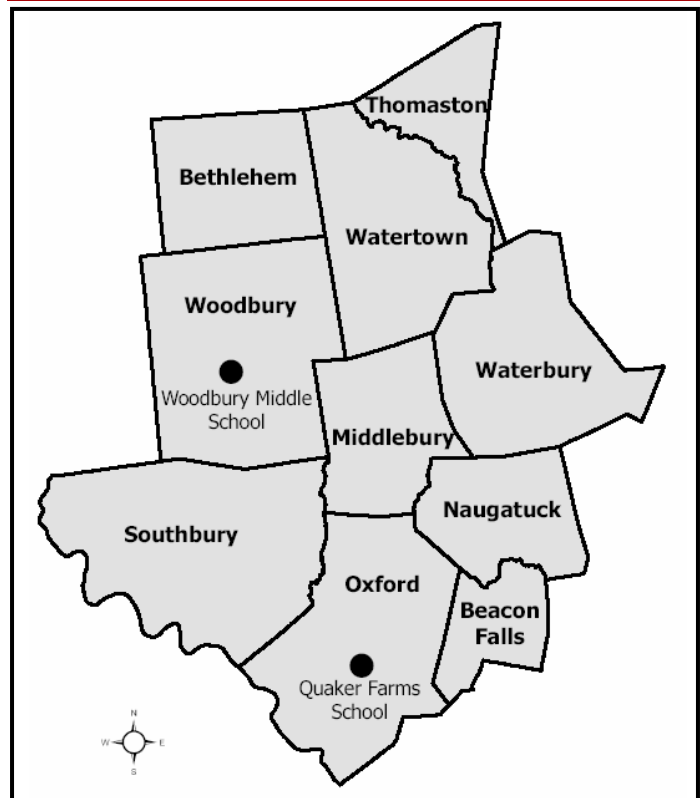
Proper disposal of latex paint

- ♦ Cans containing 1/2" or less: Open lid and air dry
- ♦ Cans with paint in excess of 1/2": Add kitty litter or speedy dry to paint to accelerate drying

Dispose of dried paint can in trash

Identifying Latex and Oil-based paints:

- ♦ Latex is water-based
- ♦ Latex cleanup uses soap-and-water
- ♦ Oil-based paints are commonly referred to as "alkyd"
